

behavioral health fall forum

Dayton Children's Health Partners held their fall clinical quality forum entitled "Have no Fear, Behavioral Health Integration is Here!" this past September. The forum highlighted the work of integrating behavioral health specialists in the primary care setting. Physicians from Child and Adolescent Specialty Care, Shelby Pediatrics and PriMed shared their learnings thus far with colocation and integration pilots.

anthem contract 2022 finalized


