Pediatric Medical Music Therapy Internship
Internship Application

The music therapy internship at Dayton Children's Hospital is available to students that have completed the required undergraduate coursework at an AMTA-approved school and who have been cleared by their academic advisor to begin internship. It is offered annually starting in July and will last a minimum of 900 hours. Applications must be received by **December 1st** of the prior year.

The following required materials should be sent in one email from the applicant to the internship director. Applications that do not follow these guidelines will not be accepted.

1. Completed application
 - a. Answers to questions. Please only use space provided.
 - b. Videos demonstrating piano, guitar, and voice abilities. Two songs sung and accompanied on guitar; two songs sung and accompanied on piano. Please allow us to see both your face and your fingers playing the guitar/piano. YouTube links are preferred.
2. College transcript – unofficial is acceptable
3. Current Curriculum Vitae (CV) including practicum placements/clinical groups

The following required materials should be sent via email directly to the internship director. Please have writer include applicant's name in the subject line.

1. Three letters of reference from music therapy supervisors or professors addressing musical, clinical, and professional skills. Please include both strengths and areas for growth.
2. One letter of eligibility from your Academic Director.

Internship applicants will be notified via email by the internship director when your application has been received. Selected applicants will have a video interview which may be followed up with an onsite interview. Be prepared to sing songs with guitar and keyboard accompaniment in response to scenarios.

Upon ***acceptance*** to the internship program: Dayton Children's Hospital will work with the intern's university to establish a legal affiliate agreement. No internship can begin until the legal affiliation is in place. An internship agreement will also be developed by the intern, the intern's academic advisor, and the internship director. Prior to the intern's start date (and at the cost of the intern), the intern must complete required health work (PPD, Rubella and Rubeola, Hepatitis B, Varicella, Tdap, influenza) and undergo fingerprinting with a criminal background check. Vaccination against COVID-19 is required.
