

correction dose

This is the insulin dose you take for high blood glucose during the day and at bedtime.

Meal time: 1 unit per 100mg/dL over 200

Bedtime: 1 unit per 100mg/dL over 300

blood glucose	daytime	bedtime
Under 201	0	0
201-300	1	0
301-400	2	1
401-500	3	2
501-600	4	3
Over 600	5	4

Only give correction dose if it has been **more than 2-3 hours** since the last dose of fast-acting insulin.
