SUGARPLUM BASKET RAFFLE

6. **Custom Tree** that the buyer would like us to design.

What I need from you.

I would like *your twig group* to find a buyer (*one*) for a pre-purchased tree. I would like you to be asking your pediatrician, dentist, or friends at church if they might be interested. If they say that they might be interested, give them the contract letter that lists all the details.

I am also looking at making 2 or 3 large 6 foot trees for a pre-sale at \$600. A nursing home, bank, or funeral home might be interested. (One suggestion would be the natural trees with fruits and silk flowers that could be left up during December and January).

For the past four years we have been selling pre-sold trees. It is a great way for a business to support Children's Hospital and have advertisement for their business. Let's try to expand on this, this year! It is a win, win for everyone!
