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Ask these conversation starter questions to spark a conversation!

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Where have you met some of the friends you have now?

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How can you make new friends?

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## Speedy Conversations

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**Instructions:** Pair up your students and give them the list of conversation questions below. Ask them to have a conversation with their partner for one minute. Encourage them to take turns answering the questions to create a back-and-forth discussion.

Some pairs may get through all the questions, while others may only need one question to get the conversation flowing.

Once the one minute timer is up, ask the pairs to share something new that they learned about their partner.

Mix up the partners for as many rounds of speedy conversations as your classroom structure permits.

### Questions:

- What is your favorite thing about school? What do you like about it?
- Tell me about what you like to do when you get home from school?
- What gift would you really like to get? Why?
- What is one thing you would like to do when you grow up? What would be cool about doing this?
- If you could have one superpower, what would it be? How would you use it?
- What activities do you really like to do ( like sports, hobbies, art, gaming)?
- What is something you want to try? Why?
