







achel Carlson, Chio





If I voice a question I immediately have multiple people offering to help, even if they aren't my direct seniors. I also had a nurse educator remember by interest in endocrinology just from meeting me at orientation, then offer me a spot on the glycemic control committee in a lunch line when she recognized me! My motto has always been, "you become like the people you spend time with," and in residency you spend most of your time with co-workers. I would be proud to become more like all of my residents and attendings. Finally, I've also been able to see so many interesting and complex cases in my first month and have experienced so much growth in my clinical decision making. There is no educational sacrifice being at a smaller children's hospital- if anything the accessibility of attendings for education makes each encounter more fruitful for learning.
