correction dose

This is the insulin dose you take for high blood glucose during the day and at bedtime.

Meal time: 0.5 unit per 100mg/dL over 200 Bedtime: 0.5 unit per 100mg/dL over 300

blood glucose	daytime	bedtime
Under 201	0	0
201-300	0.5	0
301-400	1	0.5
401-500	1.5	1
501-600	2	1.5
Over 600	2.5	2

Only give correction dose if it has been **more than 2-3 hours** since the last dose of fast-acting insulin. childrensdayton.org/diabetesresources
